What is "Palm Sunday"?

Today, we remember the day Jesus triumphantly rode into Jerusalem on a colt while being praised as King and Messiah by an enthusiastic palm-waving crowd for the Passover Feast, ending with His death on the cross and resurrection from the dead. (Matthew 21-28.

Meanings of Phrases Shouted by the Crowds to Jesus:

- "Hosanna" - "Save now" (from oppression, sin)
- "Son of David" - Jesus is the Jews' King and Messiah
- "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord" - Jesus had come from God to do His will.

About the Lord's Supper...

This morning we are observing the Lord's Supper during the worship service. The Lord's Supper is a powerful reminder of Jesus' broken body and shed blood that made forgiveness and eternal life possible. **Everyone who has put their faith in Jesus Christ and been baptized by immersion are welcome to participate.** We ask that everyone be prayerful and quiet during the observance. We will partake of the bread and juice together once everyone has been served.

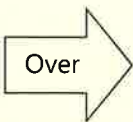

How YOU Can Become a Christian...

The decision to receive Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord is the most important decision you will ever make. Here's how you can be saved and become a Christian:

- **Realize** you have sinned and are subject to God's judgment and eternity in hell (to sin is to disobey God's commands revealed in the Bible).
- **Believe** Jesus Christ literally died on a cross to pay the penalty for your sins and rose from the dead.
- **Ask** God to forgive your sins and be willing, with God's help, to turn away from your sins (repent).
- **Ask** Jesus Christ to be your Savior and Lord. You can pray something like...
"Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and need your forgiveness. I believe you died on a cross and rose from the dead for my sins. Please forgive me for my sins and help me turn away from them. I ask you to come into my life and be my Savior and Lord."

How YOU Can Become a Member of WCBC...

Follow Jesus with Us!

You may become a member by presenting yourself or family for church membership during the "invitation" time at the conclusion of each worship service. You are invited to join the church in one of three ways:

- **By Profession of Faith and Baptism** You have received or want to receive Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord and be baptized.
- **By Transfer** of your membership from a similar Baptist church.
- **By Statement** that you were once a member of a similar Baptist church but transferring your membership is not possible or by stating that you received Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord and were baptized by immersion in a non-Baptist church (requires pastoral interview).

WCBC Member Expectations...

- Be in agreement with and promote the doctrinal beliefs of the church.
- Support the vision, mission and leadership of the church.
- Attend and participate in worship services and other programs regularly.
- Use your spiritual gifts and skills to serve God and people in and through the church.
- Live out the teachings of the Bible and do not dishonor God or His church through sinful behavior.
- Support the ministries of the church through regular giving of tithes and offerings.
