How YOU Can Become a Christian...

The decision to receive Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord is the most important decision you will ever make. Here's how you can be saved and become a Christian:

- Realize you have sinned and are subject to God's judgment and eternity in hell (to sin is to disobey God's commands revealed in the Bible).

How YOU Can Become a Member of WCBC...
