Meanings of Phrases Shouted by the Crowds to Jesus:
 Hosanna" – "Save now" or "Save us"
 "Son of David" – Jesus is the Messiah and eternal King of OT prophecy
 "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord" – Praise that Jesus had come from God to be the Savior.

Question 11:

What does God require in the sixth, seventh, and eighth commandments?

Sixth, that we do not hurt, or hate, or be hostile to our neighbor, pursuing even our enemies with love. Seventh, that we abstain from sexual immorality and live purely and faithfully, whether in marriage or in single life, avoiding all impure actions, looks, words, thoughts, or desires, and whatever might lead to them. Eighth, that we do not take without permission that which belongs to someone else. (TNCC) Romans 13:9

Baptist Christians Believe

How YOU Can Become a Christian...

The decision to receive Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord is the most important decision you will ever make. Here's how you can be saved and become a Christian:

- **Realize** you have sinned and are subject to God's judgment and eternity in hell (to sin is to disobey God's commands revealed in the Bible).
- **Believe** Jesus Christ literally died on a cross to pay the penalty for your sins and rose from the dead.
- **Ask** God to forgive your sins and be willing, with God's help, to turn away from your sins (repent).
- **Ask** Jesus Christ to be your Savior and Lord. You can pray something like...
"Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and need your forgiveness. I believe you died on a cross and rose from the dead for my sins. Please forgive me for my sins and help me turn away from them. I ask you to come into my life and be my Savior and Lord."

How YOU Can Become a Member of WCBC...

You may become a member by presenting yourself or family for church membership during the "invitation" time at the conclusion of each worship service. You are invited to join the church in one of three ways:

- **By Profession of Faith and Baptism** You have received or want to receive Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord and be baptized.
- **By Transfer** of your membership from a similar Baptist type church.
- **By Statement** that you were once a member of a similar Baptist church but transferring your membership is not possible or by stating that you received Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord and were baptized by immersion in a non-Baptist church (requires pastoral interview).
